Here, use a capital letter to indicate the beginning of a sentence of the quotation. A comma is placed at the end of the quoted dialogue, inside the quotation mark, before the speaker tag. Dialogue is indented and runs down the center of the page. Final Draft sets the proper indents for you - the left indent between an inch and one-and-a-half inches from the left margin; and a right indent of about an inch and a half. Above the block of dialogue is the name of the character speaking.
