Certified copies of marriage records may be obtained in person or by mail from the circuit court clerk's office that issued the marriage license for a fee of \$3.00 or from the Virginia Division of Vital Records in Richmond for a fee of \$12.00. The full names of the bride and groom and the date and place of marriage must be provided.

The Code of Virginia provides for over 800 responsibilities for the Clerk of Circuit Court, but his or her chief responsibilities include serving as recorder of deeds, deciding certain issues of probate, issuing marriage licenses, creating court records, and certifying and archiving all records of the circuit courts and other records as provided by law. Accomack County's current Clerk of Circuit Court, Samuel H. Cooper, Jr., was elected in November 1983.
